


**SITLINGTON PARISH COUNCIL – MIDDLESTOWN WARD**

5. Upon receipt of a valid request from 10 registered Local Government electors within the 14 working day period, an election will be held on a date to be set by the Returning Officer.
6. In the event that insufficient requests are received within the 14 working day period, the vacancy will be filled by the Parish Council by co-option.


