## Report

### Patrols

PC 2534 Richardson reports:

06/03/2018 between 1200 x 1400

High visibility traffic patrol around Netherton, concentrating on Upper Road.

2 x Verbal warnings for 33-35mph.

2 x Traffic Offence Reports for speeds between 40-45mph.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

08/03/2018 between 1230 x 1530

Patrols made of area on Off Road motorbike between 12:30 X 15:30 on 08/03/2018. Regular hotspots patrolled where bikes have known to be present. Today it was clear that no bikes had been in any of hotspot areas as the snow was undisturbed. Intelligence received regarding a locus where off road bikes are kept in Netherton. Locus visited and intelligence submitted. Patrols also made around schools due to issues with illegal parking. No issues today, however one driver stopped due to him using mobile phone. He was issued with a ticket for the offence.

## **Crime**

### **Middlestown**

There were six reported crimes in Middlestown. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a burglary residential at an address on Low Lane where the suspect/s have snapped the front door lock and stolen the keys to a Mini Cooper. They have then stolen the car. The vehicle was recovered by the police in Bradford. Enquiries are still ongoing.

The other crime consisted of a public order offence on New Road, a theft (other) on Old Road, an assault at Ridge Crescent, a make off without payment from a taxi on Nell Gap Lane and a public order offence on Albion Mews.

### **Midgley**

There were three reported crimes in Midgley. None of these were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

They were all assaults at Denby Grange School.

### **Netherton**

There were six reported crimes in Netherton. Of these four were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

There was a theft from motor vehicle on Upper Lane where the suspect/s has smashed the window of the vehicle and stolen an integrated Sat Nav as well as the indicator lights. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

There were three attempted burglary residentials at three different address on Glenfields that occurred on one night. The suspect/s have attempted to snap the lock at the properties and failed and at the third one they have been disturbed by the victim and made off. Enquiries are still ongoing into these offences.

The other crimes consisted of an assault at Brookfields and a malicious communications on Netherton Lane.

## **Overton**

There were two reported crimes in Overton. None of these were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

They were a theft (other) at New Road and an assault at Wood Mount.

## **New Hall Prison**

There were ten reported offences at New Hall. These consisted of an attempt to pervert the course of justice, four assaults, two malicious communications, a threats to kill, a possession of an offensive weapon and a threat to damage property.

## **Anti-Social Behaviour**

### **Middlestown**

There were two ASB related calls in Middlestown. The first was about nuisance youths smoking drugs at an address on Ramsey Road and the second was about a possible drug deal on Coxley Lane.

### **Midgley**

There were no ASB related calls in Midgley.

### **Netherton**

There were two ASB related calls in Netherton. The first was about poor driving in the snow on Coxley Crescent and the second was about fly tipping on South Lane.

### **Overton**

There was one ASB related call in Overton which was a report of fly tipping on Old Road.
