Patrols

PC 2534 Richardson (Safer Roads)

Crime

Middlestown

There were fifteen reported crimes in Middlestown. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a burglary residential on Nell Gap Lane where the suspect/s have gained entry via an insecure door and stolen a TV. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crimes consisted of a damage on Water Lane, public order offences on New Road and Low Lane, a theft (other) on New Road, an assault on Thornhill Road, two damage, three assaults, two assault police constables and a harassment at the same address on Albion Mews and a malicious communication on Cross Road

Midgley

There were two reported crimes in Midgley. There was an assault at Denby Grange School and a vehicle interference on Stocksmoor Road.

Netherton

There were seven reported crimes in Netherton. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

This was a theft from motor vehicle on Netherton Hall Gardens where the suspect/s have drilled a hole in the fuel tank and syphoned out petrol. All lines of enquiry have been completed and no suspect/s have been identified.

The other crime consisted of a theft (other) on Bridle Close, an assault on Netherton Lane, a harassment and stalking at the same address on Highfields and two assaults on Upper Lane.

Overton

There was one reported crime in Overton. This was an assault on Green Lane.

There were ten reported offences from New Hall Prison. These was a public order offence, two drugs offences and seven assaults.
