- Middlestown Junior School parking 3.20pm week days
- Speeding New Rd, Middlestown, Old Rd, Overton and Netherton Lane, Netherton.

Report

Patrols:

PC 2639 REPORTS - High visibility patrols re: Safe scheme between 1600x1900hrs 04/12/2018 around the entire parish; paying particular attention to Netherton Village Hall, which was visited on several occasions through the evening but no cars/youths present.

Targeted patrols in areas with speeding concerns utilising periodic static parking to deter. No calls for service.

PC99 Reports: PC 3182 BENNETT and I conducted high visibility patrols between 1400-1600 hours paying particular attention to BLACKER LANE, NETHERTON LANE and OLD LANE. There was nothing of note in respect to any ASB vehicles or youths causing issues in the area.

PC 4927 REPORTS

Safe Scheme patrols carried out on 06/12/18 between 1700 - 2130 hours.

Attended CHURCH LANE for initial road closure during Christmas tree switch on. Engagement with public.

Once this had finished, High visibility patrols carried out at the following locations:

Blacker Lane area

Netherton Lane

Old Road

Upper lane

High visibility patrols in and around Community Hall in Netherton, Netherton and surrounding areas. One vehicle present within the carpark with two male youths. Nothing of concern and males moved on. No issues to report.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out on 06/12/2018 between the hours 15:00 x 18:00

Middlestown school attended for parking issues however it was 15:40 and no issues with any vehicles parked inappropriately while in attendance.

Netherton village hall patrolled nothing of note to report after leaving my details some weeks ago I have had no further contact from staff at the youth club in regard to the silver canisters or parking while the youth club is on, I will attend again on a Wednesday and speak to the youth leaders to see if this is still an issue and update.

Pc Steel (off road motorcycles reports,

Patrols carried out on 13/12/2018 of Sitlington Parish Area between 22:00 X 00:00. General area patrolled and several vehicles stopped. No issues. Following recent reports regarding mopeds riding in anti social manner I ensured any riders I saw were stopped. All spoken to with no problems and happy to chat. The only issue was around the Village Hall at Netherton. Dog walker who I know as part of my regular patrols in area informed me there were some "dodgy youths" in the car park, I attended and located 1 x car with 2 males inside. Lots of rubbish discarded in rest of car park. Vehicle moved on and occupants advised that patrols are being undertaken in the area at all times so not to return.

Crime

Middlestown

There were nine reported crimes in Middlestown;

- On the 7th December some damage was caused to a property on Ramsey View where an unknown offender had thrown Creosote over the victim's windows.
- On the 19th December a ford fiesta was stolen from outside 2 Sandy Lane by unknown means, the vehicle is still outstanding.
- On the 28th December a burglary took place at 73 Ramsey Rd, however this proved to be domestic related and the offender has been charged with the offence.
- The other six crimes involved one theft, one public order, one nuisance calls, one harassment and two assaults. Most of these crimes being domestic related with the exception of the theft which was a shoplifting offence.

Midgley

There were two crimes reported in Midgely. A customer at the Midgley Lodge Hotel has booked one night and stayed a further two nights without paying for the privilege and a pupil at the Denby Grange School decided it would be a good idea to take a knife to school. Offenders for both incidents have been dealt with.

Netherton

There five reported crimes in Netherton.

- On the 28th December there was a burglary residential which was discovered after a vehicle was burnt out on Blacker Lane and when 12 Upper Lane, the address where the vehicle was registered to was visited, the rear had been broken into and it was clear the car along with other property had been stolen. No suspects have yet to be identified.
- Also on the 28th, an unknown person has attempted to enter a van on Coxley View but the alarm has sounded and they have ran off before anything could be taken.
- The three other crimes relate to two drive offs from the local petrol station and a theft from shop.

Overton

There was only one reported crime in Overton;

- This relates to a domestic harassment where the offender was arrested and charged.

New Hall Prison

There were five reported offences from New Hall Prison. One drugs related offence and four assaults.

Anti-Social Behaviour

There were only three reported ASB related incidents in the Sitlington Parish;

Netherton

- Parking issues on Blacker Lane where a report was made that cars were parking on the pavement causing obstructions.

Middlestown

- Youths playing loud music and taking drugs on Albion Mews.

Overton

- Parking issues on Old Rd suggesting offending vehicles were obstructing pedestrians and road users.
