Patrols

PCS0 438 Kuritzin reports:

02/01/18 between 2300 x 0100.

High visibility patrols of the Middlestown and Netherton. All areas of note checked at various times. There was nobody in the area and no calls for service.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

Patrols made today of Sitlington Parish area on Off Road motorcycle. Initially patrol made of Emroyd Woods due to recent reports of nuisance bikes. It is clear from within the woods that bikes have been used, however there have been new fences/gates erected which really limits access. I followed some tracks and it appears that the bikes are riding across the farmer's field on THORNHILL ROAD and up a banking directly into the woods. I will liaise with councillors to see if there is any way it can be fenced off. Whilst patrolling area I also spoke to several dog walkers and a horse rider who all stated the problem was a regular one, especially on a weekend.

I also patrolled Coxley Woods with no issues. I spent time at the local schools at closing time to ensure there were no issues with parking. Traffic patrols were also conducted again with no issues.

The only issue was a report of inconsiderate parking on main road out to Netherton. I located the vehicle and it transpired that the vehicles load had become insecure. I assisted the male who was struggling fastening the vehicles load back up and he then left the area.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

Further to my last, just before Christmas we caught a male riding a quad out of Coxley Woods. The quad was seized and the rider reported for summons for having no insurance. He has this week appeared at court and been issued with a £200 fine and 6 points on his licence.

PC 6487 Steel reports:

26/01/2018 between 1200 x 1400

Patrols made on off road motorbike on 26/01/2018 between 12:00 X 14:00 hrs. Patrolled local woods in Middlestown and then in Netherton. No issues at all and no fresh tracks noticed. Spent some time on main road coming from Horbury into area due to reports of bad driving. A male was seen on a motorbike overtaking vehicles at speed and doing so crossing solid white lines. Due to manner of driving I was unable to follow the rider however registration details were obtained. It transpires the bike is a courtesy bike provided by an insurer. I contacted them and have traced the rider to a well-known male in the Netherton area. I have arranged for him to attend Ossett Police Station. Update to follow.

No other issues in the area.

PCSO 438 Kuritzin reports:

31/01/18 between 2300hrs and 0100hrs.

High visibility patrols of Middlestown and Netherton. All areas of note checked at various times. A vehicle was PNC checked that was parked with occupants inside in the car park of Netherton Community Centre. Other than that there was nothing else to note and no calls for service.

<u>Crime</u>

Middlestown

There were six reported crimes in Middlestown. Of these two were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a report of a theft of motor vehicle from New Road. The vehicle was found abandoned in Liversedge. At this time the investigation is still ongoing.

The second was a report of a burglary residential on Water Lane Close where the suspect/s have gained entry through an insecure door and removed car keys. They have then stolen the vehicle. At this time the investigation is still ongoing.

The other reported crime was an act of outraging public decency where a suspect has defecated on the back door step of the White Swan Hotel, a public order offence on Ridge Road and an assault at the Little Bull pub. There was also a report of a robbery at an address on Nell Gap Lane, but this was later proved to be false.





Midgley

There were no reported crimes in Midgley.

Netherton

There were four report crimes in Netherton in January. Of these one was classed as a serious acquisitive crime.

WEST YORKSHIRE POLICE

This was a report of an attempted burglary residential at an address on Coxley View where the suspect/s have bent the garage door back attempting to gain entry. They have failed and left empty handed. All lines of enquiry have been completed and the crime has been filed.

The other crime consisted of an assault on Coxley Crescent, a malicious communication on Upper Lane and a theft of plant tubs from Oakland Drive.

Overton

There were no reported crimes in Overton.

New Hall Prison

There were fourteen reported offences from New Hall Prison. These consisted of a drugs offences, possession of a prohibited article, ten assaults and two sexual assaults.

Middlestown
