## PC2819 Brumby reports

I attended Old Rd and spoke with **Example** who has shown concerns regards the speeding issues in that area. I have actioned traffic officers to pay particular attention to that area and I stood and observed for a short time myself and the issue was evident even for only a few minutes.

I have also spoken to a few residents around Netherton Village Hall and they confirmed the issues and also Bikes were becoming an issue. Again, I have directed officers when and where possible to perform some patrols and move individuals on should there be any issues.

# <u>Crime</u>

## Middlestown

There were eleven reported crimes in Middlestown. None of these crimes were serious and acquisitive in nature and of those eleven reported, none I feel will have an impact on the community.

# Midgley

There were no reported crimes in Midgley in July.

## Netherton

There six reported crimes in Netherton. Of these three were classed as serious acquisitive crimes.

The first was a 2 in 1 burglary on Netherton Lane where the house was entered and the vehicle stolen, a suspect has been arrested and charged with the offence. The second being a sneak in Burglary on Upper Lane where an unknown suspect has entered the property in the day whilst the occupants are watching TV and they have taken items from in the kitchen. The third was an attempt



burglary on Brookfields where unknown offenders have attempted to snap the locks on the patio doors but entry was not gained.

The other three crimes reported have not had an impact on the community.

# Overton

There was one reported crime in Overton which was a domestic related incident.

# New Hall Prison

There were ten reported offences from New Hall Prison. These were four drugs/contraband offences and six assaults.

# Anti-Social Behaviour

## Middlestown

Two reports of ASB in Middlestown, the first being a report of youths on the park on Parkside causing issues and being rowdy, incident passed to NPT. The second being a drunken male annoying residents on Nell Gap Lane, male had left area before police deployment.

## Midgley

There were no ASB related calls in Midgley.

## Netherton

There was only one report of ASB in Netherton, this related to an argument between neighbours on Coxley View, officers deployed to lower tensions, no impact outside those involved.

#### Overton

There were no ASB related calls in Overton.
