Patrols:

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme carried out on 08/08/2019 between the hours of 16:00 and 20:00

Plain cloths patrols carried out in Emroyd common number of persons spoken to including people using the bike track. There was no issues reported from any persons using the common including numerous dog walkers.

No motorbikes seen during the hours patrolled or evidence of them being in and around the common.

Patrols will continue in the common.

All other areas of the Parish patrolled no calls for service or ASB witnessed at the time.

PC 2534 Richardson (Roads Policing)

19.08.2019 12x15hrs

Speed enforcement conducted on Upper Lane/New Road.

Very light traffic flow, in excess of 50 vehicles checked no offences.

PC 6487 Steel reports,

Patrols made on off road bike on 20/08/2019 between 13:00 x 15:00.

All usual hotspots patrolled in relation to nuisance bikes. Numerous kids spoken to in Emroyd Common area due to school holidays but no issues regarding motorbikes (or push bikes).

WEST YORKSHIRE POLICE

1 report received of males fly tipping on tracks near to Coxley Woods. Van located and checks conducted. The area was overlooked by1 house which I attended at and it was confirmed that the males in the van were actually cleaning up the rubbish which had been dumped by someone else across the road blocking any sort of access. Occupants of van I spoke to were local residents who understood why I stopped them.

Whilst dealing with this incident a lost dog ran past and caused problems as it ran onto main road. Traffic controlled whilst owner arrived and managed to get dog under control.

PC 2639 Gallagher reports

High visibility SAFE SCHEME patrols between 1500x1800hrs on 22/8/19.

All areas of the parish were covered in attempt to locate speeding vehicles, but none were found. Netherton Village Hal I- No youths present & no vehicles present - No issues. Netherton Cricket (Social) Club - no youths present. Spoke with local dog walkers, explaining SAFE SCHEME. All were pleased to see Officers.

PC 2639 Gallagher reports

SAFE SCHEME patrols conducted between 1500x1800hrs on 28/8/19.

All areas of the parish were covered including:

Netherton Village Hall- No vehicles present, a small number of youths playing with a ball on the tarmac - No issues.

Netherton Cricket (Social) Club - No youths present.

Emroyd common - A couple of youths on Mountain bikes present where the bikes normally congregate. All were polite & engaging stating they stay off the main paths. No sign of any new jumps being created since my last visit. Very little litter & generally paths appeared clear & tidy. Some dog walkers present who had not experienced any problems with youths

<u>Crime</u>

Middlestown

Burglary commercial at Capri BISTRO between times stated suspects approach business premises and use unknown implement to smash front window. Enter and search before removing property. Egress as entry.

Theft from Motor vehicle at Middlestown commercial vehicle repairs 3 suspects approach fence surrounding car park. One suspect stays on street outside the garage car park. The other two suspects climb wall into the car park. They approach 4 vehicles parked in the car park and jack them up. They then get under the vehicles and using tools they have brought with them remove the diesel particulate filters from the vehicles before making off with same unseen.

Netherton

Burglary residential attacked property is a semi-detached house in built up residential area. Access to front from drive to a front door and access to property through a side door. Entry had been gained through side door which is upvc with euro profile lock. Lock has been attacked with unknown tool. Property is a cannabis farm and 3 suspects have been seen by anon witness making off from scene carrying bags presumed to be containing cannabis. Suspects have made off in a vehicle which has been sighted by police and stopped. Vehicle found to be containing cannabis and occupants arrested.

Overton

Burglary commercial at Denby Grange School Attacked premises is a school which is currently under renovation. Between times stated suspect enters premises using keys previously stolen, once inside the suspect forces entry to a locked part of the building by smashing a wooden door causing damage to the same and steals a lockbox containing knives. Suspect make off unseen.

Burglary residential attacked premises are residential dwelling. Times stated suspects enter dwelling snapping locks. Untidy search made items taken including vehicle from the driveway.

New Hall Prison

There were 6 recorded crimes which occurred at the prison these were all assaults
