Patrols:

PC 2534 Richardson reports

29/06/2019

Speed enforcement commenced on New Road, Middletown. Between 11:20-13:40.

1 x verbal advice regarding excess speed which turned out to be a DVLA Seizure for expired Road Tax back in Feb 2018. (Over hour waiting for recovery)

2 x Excess Speed Traffic offence reports. 39mph

PC 6487 Steel reports,

Patrols made of area on Off Road Motorbike on 10/07/2019 between 13:00 X 15:00. As usual I patrol the wooded areas initially due to been on off road bike. In relation to Emroyd Common I was stopped by a local resident who had contacted the police so I dealt with the log. He took me into the woods to show me access points for nuisance bikes and states more have been in recently. Form A submitted and rest of Op Matrix notified. No bikes today.

Whilst in the woods adjacent to Stoneycliffe Wood I was approached by a dog walker who stating there was a pair of suspicious males at the back end of the woods as you enter Netherton. I located these 2 males who were just out walking. Both were in drink so were a bit loud but no offences. They left the area after I spoke with them.

Netherton Junior School patrolled and parking monitored. No issues at all and lots of parents/pupils spoken to. 2 X mopeds stopped between Netherton and moped and all checked out with no issues.

Middlestown

There were 2 residential burglaries in July one of high value £165,000 taken enquiries are still ongoing with the investigation. The other a mobile phone has been taken when the occupants have been in the garden and the door has been left insecure. There was one criminal damage recorded where garden furniture was damaged by and unknown person, the crime has been filed pending any new evidence coming to light.

There were 16 other crimes recorded in July as follows 4 x domestic assaults, 3 x public order offences, 2 domestic harassments and 7 sexual offences 6 of these involved the same victim but separate suspects.
