Report

Patrols:

PC 2639 Gallagher Reports

High visibility Safe Scheme patrols on foot & vehicle carried out between 1530x1730hrs on 12/06/19

All areas of the parish covered, including the Village Hall. As usual, there were a number of kids in the park next to the hall who I have spoken with before, who all engaged well - No ASB to report. Also spoke with a number of members of the community who were all happy to engage & pleased to see uniformed officers.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out between the hours of 15:30 and 17:30 on 13/06/2019

Mobile patrol around the parish due to the inclement weather - Main focus was schools - no parking issues & the village hall. There were no kids in the park next to the village hall, nor did we see any elsewhere (again most likely due to the weather) There was no calls for service nor any ASB.

PC 1845 Blore Reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out between the hours of 15:30 and 17:30 on 18/05/2019

Exclusive foot patrol of Emroyd Common due to recent conversation with members of the Parish Council who have reported further instances of nuisance type behaviour around cycling in the wooded area. Officer spoke with two youths; [REDACTED] who were shaping existing jumps in an area off of the footpaths. Both were polite, engaging & happy to speak with Officers. [REDACTED] claims to have recently spoken with Sue from the Parish Council & struck up an agreement with her about cycling so long as they do not encroach on to the footpath - this will be verified by Officer. It was clear that no damage was being caused on this occasion & could not locate any evidence of new trees being cut down; though some logs appear to have been collected/stockpiled as though someone will return to take them out of the woods (likely to be adults for log burners). No other members of the public sighted during the time spent inside the woods & no other issues.

PC 2639 Gallagher reports

High visibility Safe Scheme patrols on foot & vehicle carried out between 1530x1730hrs on 19/06/19

All areas of the parish covered, paying particular attention to Denby Grange Cricket Club following reports of possible drug dealing. No vehicles present on arrival, though Officer spoke with local resident who stated he has previously moved vehicles on from the car park who looked "dodgy", but no evidence of wrong doing - no vehicle details - details left with resident to contact Officer direct with information should this continue. Also the Village Hall. There were a number of girl in the park next to the hall who were sat talking - No ASB to report. Also spoke with a number of members of the community who were all happy to engage & pleased to see uniformed officers.

There were no calls for service nor parking issues at the schools.

PC Steel reports

Patrols made of area as part of SAFE scheme on 20/06/2019 between 14:00 X 16:00.

Schools were patrolled with no issues. I was on the off road bike so I spent some time inside the woods. The BMX tracks were obvious to see but no new damage has been caused. Coxley woods were fine with no obvious motorbike tracks. The only incident was a group of kids who were hanging around the junior school and appeared like they might be about to climb over. This was passed to me by a concerned resident. I attended and saw the youths who were all moved away from the area. No offences.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out on 25/06/2019 between the hours of 15:30 x 17:30

Attention was paid to Emroyd common however due to the poor weather there were no persons present and the BMX track didn't appear to have been changed since the last patrols were carried out.

Speed checks carried out on Upper Lane but again due to poor visibility and weather conditions all vehicles travelling at appropriate speeds.

Village hall attended but no issues

No calls for service or ASB reported in the area while carrying out the patrols

There were no calls for service or parking issues at the schools.

Crime

Middlestown

There has been a number of crimes recorded in Middlestown however none of these were the notable crimes. There were 5 recorded domestic incidents mainly assaults which have all had positive action taken.

4 x assaults

1 x public order offence

Netherton

There was one recorded drugs offence where the suspect was identified and police action taken against the male for possession of a class B controlled drug.

Overton

There was a public order offence recorded after a neighbour dispute which the neighbourhood police team are managing. The other recorded incident was a sexual offence.

New Hall Prison

There were 4 theft from motor vehicles recorded at the prison along with a number of assaults during the month.

Anti-Social Behaviour

There has been 4 reported incidents of ASB during the month of June 3 in the Middlestown area and 1 in the Overton area. The Middlestown reports include 2 x criminal damage or threats to commit damage that have been dealt with by the Neighbourhood police team and a concern for safety involving after being seen in just his pants, it transpired that he had had a house party and people wouldn't leave his address. The incident was resolved by response officers and no criminal offence had taken place.

The Overton incident was a report of Nuisance to a neighbour via Facebook again this was dealt with by the neighbourhood police team.
