### Report

### Patrols:

### PC Steel reports,

Patrols made as part of SAFE scheme between 12:30hrs X 15:30 hrs on 10/05/2019.

Patrols made of all local wooded areas. I was on the off road motorcycle so access was easy and full woods checked. Spoke to several horse riders who felt the nuisance bike problem was very intermittent but due to recent bad weather it had completely stopped.

I also conducted school patrols in relation to parking etc, and then monitored traffic due to complaints about speeding. No issues at all in any of the areas mentioned.

### PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out between the hours of 15:00 and 18:00 on 13/05/2019

Foot patrol and mobile patrol around the parish concentrating on the village hall. There was a number of kids in the park next to the village hall but all engaged with officer. There was no ASB to report and kids were using the park as it's supposed to be. Spoke to a number of members of the community who were all. Pleased to see uniformed officers patrolling.

There was no calls for service or parking issues at the schools.

#### PC 6509 DAVIS REPORTS

Safe Scheme Patrols 14.5.19 commencing between 16.15 Hrs until 19.00 Hrs. Mobile and Foot patrols in the area, plenty of children in the Park adjacent to Village Hall No ASB behaviour. Local residents spoken to, all in good spirit, nothing of note to report many people about generally in gardens due to good weather, no parking issues.

### PC 6509 DAVIS REPORTS

Safe Scheme Hi Visibility patrols carried out between 1500 and 1800 Hrs. No offences disclosed. Plenty of people about due to good weather, There were a number of children playing in the park all good natured. The Village Hall was open at 17.40Hrs for training, no parking left but no obstructions on the street.

Heavy Traffic around Midgley and the Parish at 17.25Hrs however after 6 much lighter.

### **Crime**

### Middlestown

There were five reported crimes in Middlestown;

- On the 11<sup>th</sup> May a property on Water Lane was entered by snapping the locks on the patio doors and once inside, offenders have stolen the occupant's vehicle with keys.
- On 04th May a property on Thornhill Close was damaged after a house party
- On 24<sup>th</sup> May fence damaged at a property on Nell Gap Lane
- The other crimes relate to public order offences, and domestics

### **Netherton**

There were six reported crimes in Netherton;

- On the 07<sup>th</sup> May an address on Coxley View had a window smashed. The suspect removed money and jewellery
- The other crimes relate to domestic incidents

#### Overton

There was one crime reported in Overton of a sexual nature

### **New Hall Prison**

There were 5 reported offences from New Hall Prison. Three assaults and one drugs.
