Report**Patrols:****PC 2534 Richardson (Roads Policing)**

Visible patrol around the Netherton/Horbury /Overton/Middlestown.

Speed enforcement conducted on New Road, Horbury. Middlestown speed enforcement not conducted due to road works sub dewing traffic anyway. Checks conducted in other areas but all below prosecution levels.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrol carried out on 04/09/2019 between 15:00 x 1800

Patrolled around the schools in the parish after reports of bad parking during drop off and collection times no vehicles causing an issue or parked inconsiderately. Patrols will continue at the relevant times to monitor the reported issue.

Netherton village hall patrolled after reports of increased ASB at locus during the patrolled times nothing of note to report although the weather wasn't the best which more than likely contributed to the limited footfall around the parish in general.

Emroyd Common patrolled no persons in the common mainly due to the weather patrols will continue however with this area been a parish priority.

No calls for service during the patrolled times

PC 6487 Steel reports,

SAFE scheme patrols conducted on 10th September between 14:00 X 16:00. Patrols made of local schools at closing time to tackle problems with parking. Liaises with school crossing patrol and monitored traffic. No issues however this was probably due to my presence as I was told my lots of parents that the parking is a problem.

Patrolled local woods (Emroyd/Coxley) with no issues. There were however obvious bike tracks in Coxley woods which is something I haven't seen for a while. Spoke to several horse riders in the woods who stated there has been an increase in bikes this last couple of weeks. This is probably due to the surrounding fields been cropped which means the fields are very easy to ride on. Once they are rotivated in the upcoming weeks the issues should cease.

General traffic monitored with 1 x Ticket issued to a motorist for using mobile phone whilst driving.

PC 2639 Gallagher reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out between 15:00 x 19:00 on 19/09/2019

School parking areas checked for parking offences no offences at the time of patrolling the schools.

Netherton village hall patrolled after recent concerns with youths taking drugs and hanging around potentially causing damage. A number of youths in the area but all engaged with officer, the youths were playing football and utilising the park are all good natured and no offences been committed.

Emroyd Common patrolled on foot no person present in the common at the time of patrolling.

The rest of the Parish was patrolled on foot and mobile no calls for service during the patrolled hours.

PC 6487 Steel reports,

Patrols made as part of SAFE scheme on 22/09/2019 between 14:00 X 16:00. Information received suggests that Sundays are a busy day for motorbikes hence why this time for the patrols. Patrols were undertaken on off road bike. Unfortunately the weather was very poor which resulted in no bike activity at all. All local woods were patrolled but there were no issues whatsoever. Spoke to lots of dog walkers and a horse rider who said they had seen the odd bike in the woods but no real issues.

Also monitored traffic around the area. Several mopeds stopped and spoken to in Netherton. All polite and fully legal. No other issues.

Crime

Middlestown

There has been one commercial burglary in Middlestown where a vehicle has reversed into the shutters of the property causing extensive damage no property seems to have been taken and the crime is still under investigation.

There has been one theft from motor vehicle where the owner has been working in the rear garden of the property leaving his vehicle insecure at the front and 2 x mobile phones are taken. The crime has been filed pending any new information coming to light.

Two criminal damages have occurred one where youths have thrown eggs at a window which has broken as a result and the other where an electric fence has been cut in 3 places. The crimes have been filed due to no suspects been identified at this time.

There were seven other recorded crimes which included 7 assaults, 2 sexual offence and 1 theft from shop

Netherton

There has been one Burglary residential in Netherton where entry has been gained and a heater removed by unknown means. The suspects have made off unseen, the crime has been filed pending any new information coming to light.

Criminal damage recorded where a patio door has been smashed while occupant is in the room, no persons seen around the area and the crime has been filed pending any further information coming to light.

There were 4 other crimes recorded 3 theft related offences and one public order offence

Overton

There was only one crime recorded in Overton which was a sexual offence.

New Hall Prison

There were 22 recorded crimes which occurred at the prison these were all assaults
