Patrols made as part of SAFE scheme on 19/03. Patrols conducted between 13:00 X 15:00. Patrols conducted on off road motorbike. Report recieved of nuisance bikes in woods around Netherton. I was in the area within minutes and an off road bike seen in the distance heading towards Dewsbury area. HFollowing this initial sighting he was not seen again. I further parolled Coxley woods and found numerous bike tracks leading upto New Hall Prison. No other sightings however.

The path leading through the woods to Earnshaws wood yard is closed and fenced off dye to repairs so this should limit access for bikes for the foreseeable. I have also passed on this information tocolleagues on bike team.

General traffic patrols were then conducted around the schools at closing time, however due to current issues there was limited children at the school so no issues.
