PC Steel reports,

Patrols carried out as part of SAFE scheme patrol on 29/09/2020.

Patrols initially made of cross roads in Middlestown area following reports of vehicles contravening red lights. Lights were monitored for some time with no issues at all.

I also patrolled the quarry area and spoke to several dog walkers who said the issues with groups of youths in the area had not been particularly bad recently. No signs of litter etc today.

I patrolled wooded areas on off road bike. Spoke to horse riders within Coxley Woods who were happy to see a police presence but had no issues. Whilst patrolling the woods I spent some time around South Lane and located what appeared to be fly tipped Asbestos Roofing. This has been reported to the council.

Sandy Lane area was also patrolled. Spoke to a couple of local residents who had no issues at all and no

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrol carried out on Wednesday 23rd September 2020 between 15:00 and 18:00.

Foot and mobile patrol carried out between the hours stated however due to the inclement weather the Parish had very little footfall. Sandy patrolled for the mentioned drug dealing and speeding vehicles noting of note to report on either.

Attended Denby Grange school area and carried out foot patrol around the wooded area no sign of fires or youths hanging around at the patrolled times. All other areas of the parish patrolled nothing of note to report and no calls for service during the times.

PCSO 366 ADAMS REPORTS;

Patrols undertaken as part of safe scheme on 16/09/2020 between 16:15-18:15hrs

High vis patrols were conducted in the following areas;

Nell Gap Lane- On going drug dealing location however nothing to report.

Denby Grange sports ground- spoke to a Harrison Barton who lives on WOODMOUNT, he was in company with a female however they were not causing any issues. I also spoke with the staff at the sports ground who stated the youths have been fine today.

Sandy Lane- No issues to report

Coxley Lane- Patrolled the car park and wooded area as a current drug/ asb area, no cars present and no youths however, there was a off road bike which I was unable to catch up with.

Ramsey Road- Spoke to a XXX and XXX who are part of the group of youths who have been causing issues at the sports ground. XXX is in a leg brace so couldn't walk and XXX has now informed me he has moved to the XXXX area so he wouldn't be going to the sports ground as it's too far.

Netherton Village Hall- A group of 4 youths aged approx 8-10yrs were on their bikes causing no issues.

PCSO ADAMS 366 REPORTS:

Patrols undertaken as part of SAFE SCHEME on 05/09/2020 between 1730-1930 hrs.

High vis patrols were conducted in the following areas;

Nell Gap Lane- ongoing drug dealing location however nothing to report.

Denby Grange sports ground- current asb spot for youths. A group of around 6 youths were under the stand, however they were not doing anything to report. 1 of the youths had a rucksack on him and he showed me the contents to prove that they were not drinking alcohol however there was nothing in it other than his coat and valubles.

Coxley Lane- Recent intel has been submitted for the car park at the end of this location for drug use/ vehicle asb, there were no vehicles present at this time. The residents have placed some dummy cctv cameras at this location and have also got permission from the land owener to block the car park off after 2200hrs.

PC Steel reports,

Before lockdown and the temporary freezing of SAFE scheme I seized a moped from a local male in Middlestown for having no insurance. This was done during a SAFE scheme patrol. The rider has now been to court and fined £811 and given 8 points on his licence.

Crime

Middlestown

There were two reported crimes in Middlestown.

One was a domestic related assault, whilst the second was a vehicle intereference where the suspect has broken into a vehicle and stolen the ignition barrel. There have been no similar offences in the locality so it appears this may have been a one off.

Midgley

There has been one reported crime in Midgley which was an assault at Denby Grange School between students. A suspect has been identified and this is been dealt with.

Netherton

There have been three reported crimes in Netherton. A house garage was broken into and a low value item stolen. There have been no similar reports in the local area so again hopefully this is a one off. No suspects at this time.

A cat has been poisoned in the area, although it is obviously impossible to say where the poisoning took place. Unfortunately the cat had to be put to sleep as a result of the poisoning.

A male has been arrested after waving an imitation firearm at a known associate. This male was involved in numerous other offences in nearby areas around the same time and was subsequently arrested following a vehicle pursuit. The suspect is currently on bail with conditions not to enter Netherton.

Overton

There has been one report in Overton. 2 males were seen damaging hanging baskets and outdoor lighting belonging to a local pub. 2 X suspects were arrested at the scene and have been positively dealt with.
