Report

Patrols:

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made of area on 02/02/2019 between 00:00 X 02:00. Suspicious car reported to me near Go Outdoors. Car was located and found to contain an amorous couple. Both advised to leave the area which they did sheepishly. General patrols of local housing estates. Very little movement. 1 X moped stopped near village hall but all in order.

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made of Area on 04/02/2019 between 23:00 X 01:00. There was a lot of activity in the area due a burglary of a business which occurred at Horbury Bridge at approx 23:30hrs. I sighted the offending vehicle heading into Middlestown at around midnight however it made off believed towards Dewsbury and no further sightings were made. As a result I passed this information out and numerous other units including traffic spent considerable time in the area. There was certainly no opportunities for any offences to be committed due to the high amount of officers in the area. Other than this I patrolled the usual hot spot areas. There were no gatherings of cars/mopeds/youths and no other calls for service.

PC 1845 Blore reports 13/02

Safe scheme carried out between the hours of 15:00 x 19:00 in and around the parish area. Spoke to several members of the public including member from the parish council while patrolling at Netherton village Hall. We discussed CCTV been placed on the hall which will be installed sometime next week. We were also informed about an Akita dog that was roaming the village however a search was carried out to no gain and we had no more reports about the dog. Parking at the schools was checked and all in order at the times of patrol.

PC 2639 REPORTS - High visibility safe scheme patrols conducted between 1500x1900hrs on 13/2/19.

All areas of the Parish covered; including Netherton Village hall - No issues; no youths present

PC Steel reports,

Patrols made between 00:00 X 02:00 on 22/02/2019. Suspicious car reported due to belief that occupants were smoking cannabis. Area search made to no gain. No other reports received. General patrols made of area with no issues. Church hall monitored and absolutely no vehicles whatsoever. Earlier on in my shift I attended the woods on the Off Road Bike in relation to males digging up the woods to make BMX tracks. Nobody was present however it is apparent that the woods have been dug over. I will liaise with local parish council to see whether or not the area is protected which will then give us more powers to deal with any culprits.

Crime

Middlestown

There were nine reported crimes in Middlestown;

- On the 24th February a TV was damaged when it hit with a motorcycle helmet, this was domestic related.
- The other eight crimes consisted of 5 assaults, two nuisance calls and one sexual images related incident.

Midgley

There was one assault reported in Midgley in February at the local school.

Netherton

There were four reported crimes in Netherton;

- On the 6th, a wheelie bin was set on fire on Coxley View and on the 19th, a window was smashed at the Trinity Church.
- The other two crimes relate to a child protection issue and a sexual images type incident.

Overton

There were four reported incidents in Overton in February. These consisted of two harassments, one nuisance call and one sexual images incident.

New Hall Prison

There were eight reported offences from New Hall Prison. Six assaults, one damage and one drugs.
