Report

Patrols:

PC 1845 Blore reports

Patrols carried out between the hours of 15:00 and 19:00 07/01/19

All area's patrolled in and around the Sitlington area including the rural parts due to recent reports of mopeds rising in and ASB manner. Nothing of note seen.

Cricket club checked and all in order no youths at the time of attending.

Village hall Netherpton checked all in order and no persons hanging around.

PC 2639 REPORTS – Safe scheme patrols conducted between 1500x1900hrs on 8/1/19 around the entire parish; paying particular attention to Netherpton Village Hall & other sites with large car parks away from public view, which were visited on several occasions through the evening but no gatherings present. (One scooter did pull into the Village Hall car park, but turned around & left once Officers were sighted).

Targeted patrols in areas with speeding concerns utilising periodic static parking to deter.

No calls for service.

PC 1845 Blore reports

Safe scheme patrols carried out on Monday 14/01/2019 between 15:00 x 18:00

Full parish patrolled in marked vehicle providing high-visibility reassurance. Attention paid to school parking in Middlestown no issues while in area.

Netherpton village Hall attended, while parked only one youth spoken to who was walking his dog but happy to speak to officers asked if he had seen any of the reported issues but stated he hadn't.

There was no signs of any ASB vehicles or evidence of Gas canisters after a walk around the centre.

This will be continuously monitored while working Safe as I am aware that it is at specific times mainly when the youth club is open I will endeavour to attend at this time and speak to the staff.

No calls for service or other issues to report.

PC 1845 REPORTS – Safe scheme patrols conducted between 1500x1800hrs on 15/1/19 around the entire parish including Netherpton Village Hall & Denby Grange Cricket Club, which were visited on several occasions through the evening but no gatherings present. Targeted patrols in areas with speeding concerns utilising periodic static parking to deter.

PC 6254 Varley (RPU) reports:

Sitlington Safer Scheme conducted between 1900x2200hrs on 23/01/19.

PC Steel (off road motorbike) reports,

Patrols made of Sitlington Parish area on 21st and 22nd January, on both occasions between 23:00 X 01:00. Majority of patrols spent around Village Hall in relation to nuisance cars and mopeds. There was a lot of rubbish in the car park but on both days only 1 car parked up. Spoke to occupants who left the area. 1 X moped was stopped on the 1st night as it came into the car park. All checks were completed and no issues.

General patrols of area also made. 2 x males stopped and spoken to near Star Pub however they were just heading home with no issues.

No other problems.

PC 2639 REPORTS - high visibility Safe scheme patrols conducted between 1500x1800hrs 29/01/19. All parts of the parish covered, with particular attention given to the village hall. Spoke with several members of the public who were utilising the hall, who reported no issues, but were pleased to see Officers.

Crime

Middlestown

There were nine reported crimes in Middlestown;

- On the 4th January a mobile phone was damage when it was thrown at a wall, this was domestic related.
- The other nine crimes were mainly domestic related, four assaults, one threat and one harassment. The none domestic related incidents involved a robbery and a drugs related incident.

Midgley

There were no reported crimes in Midgley in January.

Netherton

There was only one reported crime reported in Netherton, this relates to a domestic assault.

Overton

There was only one reported crime in Overton, this related to a broken down vehicle which was parked on Wood Lane in the early hours of new year's day. Damaged was caused by an unknown person by scratching the side of the vehicle.

New Hall Prison

There were eight reported offences from New Hall Prison. Five damages and three assaults.
